For use and maintenance purposes we suggest the following fees/donations. They are graduated by the size of your group as we are collecting them for maintenance and services and someone to come out and turn these on. All donations help us to maintain the property throughout the year and bring the festival each Memorial Day Weekend. As a suggestion, we have found that if each person that is able can pay their own fee, the donations cover expenses well and are easier to pay.
